Read, Renew, Repeat

One of the most striking differences from 19th century libraries and today's library is the amount of time, energy and funds spent on providing programs for the community. What used to be a narrow lane of literacy-aligned programs for young children, has morphed into an all-ages, year-round, line-up of events for people from all walks of life.

This pivot in services does not come at the expense of our core values, as access to information still lies at the heart of our field. When the Burlington Public Library was created knowledge was very much static; meaning that it couldn't travel very fast. People needed to actively relay information from one person to the next, and information was most often bound in a book.

Fast forward to 2024 where information now exists in a fluid state. Access to the internet has given the masses instantaneous publishing opportunities from social media platforms to blogs, vlogs, podcasts, and more.

With the onset of so many rapid-fire digital connections, many in-person connections have gone by the wayside. This is where the modern public library finds itself filling a unique need for communities the world over. We're bringing people together who otherwise might not interact.

The Burlington Public Library provides opportunities for all people to connect with others (That's Yesterday's News, Do Art Comic Workshop, Storytime), to learn about the world around them (Insect Zoo, Baby Sensory, The Great Outdoors) and to imagine the futures before them (Star Lab with NASA, Adventures with Green Iowa AmeriCorps, Mental Health Mondays).




