
#### **Frost Fair**

In an ironic twist, January's Frost Fair was rescheduled to February due to dangerously low temperatures, and on February 23rd the BPL team hosted a full-day winter extravaganza. From a concert with guitarist Forest McCurren to a live ice carving demonstration, we offered a variety of opportunities for people to explore history, music and the arts at this year's Frost Fair.





This event was inspired by the Frost Fairs of London held on the frozen River Thames circa the 1550's. As a river town ourselves, a Frost Fair themed event fits well with our community and offers our patrons an opportunity to get out and explore the world around them from the comfort of their own public library.



#### **Advocacy**

On the same evening of our Love Your Library Month Proclamation, City Council decided to back-fill the FY25 budget with local options sales tax. Many of those present for the proclamation were there for discussions around the library budget in light of the loss of our library levy due to last year's HF718.

This stop-gap secures another year of funding for BPL, but requires City staff, Library Trustees, and the Council to begin having conversations around the FY26 budget now. The Burlington Public Library is the oldest and longest-running library in the State of Iowa, and we intend to keep that streak going long into the future.

Comments from the public, conversations with city and library leaders, and the statistics showing how the community uses this library all helped to give us momentum going into this budget season. Our community loves this library, and everyday advocacy from folks championing the library via word of mouth, social media, and library use will be the foundation on which we stand throughout these turbulent financial times.
