By opening up our summer program to readers of all ages, we're casting a wider net and welcoming more of our community to take part in our single largest initiative. Though summer reading began as a program nation-wide targeting school-aged children, we now know that positive examples of adult literacy have an impact on children's literacy journeys in addition to the incredible benefits that reading has for people of all ages.

In order to level up our reading program and make it appealing for adults to join-in, we've partnered with the Burlington's Forestry Department. By reading with us this summer people can exchange their reading credits towards the planting of trees in our community. We have set a lofty goal of 'unlocking' 50 trees to plant, and at the end of June we were more than half-way there!

As a Tree City USA and a newly minted Tree City World, this initiative turns everyone into a philanthropist by allowing us all to give back to the community now, and years down the road when folks benefit from the trees that we will plant this summer.

In partnership with Fareway, and thanks to a large food donation to the library, we've been able to host breakfast for nearly 40 kids each week of June. 




